Friday February 22, 2013**

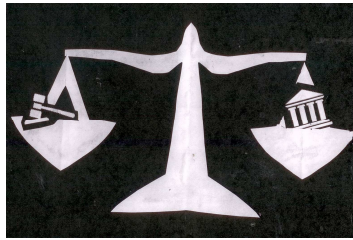
The Legal Issues in Conservation Working Group is holding its 2011-2014 interim meeting on Friday, February 22, 2013 in Amsterdam, The Netherlands. Getting to the Cultural Heritage Agency (RCE):

From the airport, take the train to Amsterdam Centraal. Make sure that you get on a train that goes North to Amsterdam Centraal; half of the trains go East into the Dutch wilderness.

From Amsterdam Central you can take streetcar/tram 2 or 5 to the stop Hobbemastraat / Rijksmuseum. (The stop before is Leidseplein.) When you get off, walk in the travelling direction. You will have the Rijksmuseum on your left and Museumplein (Museum Square) on your right. After passing the Cobra Restaurant/Café on your right, you will reach a short street which is also Hobbemastraat. On the right, you will see three older buildings. RCE is the middle one with the word "Veiligheidsinstituut" in stone in the façade. Register at the reception desk, and they will let you in. Go upstairs one floor. The meeting is in the main room in the center of the foyer.
