

## **Programme 2002-2005**

### **Wood, Furniture and Lacquer**

The working group will cover all areas of wood such as wooden objects, wooden furniture, ethnographic wood (totem poles etc), wood technology, archeological wood and wood science, as well as all areas of lacquer and related materials.

The ICOM-CC Wood and Furniture Working Group programme for the next triennial period (2002-2005) is including the following:

1. To collect more members for the group to establish a big one as a start for an active WG.
2. To organize the group as a kind of systematic body with coordinators for each continent of the six continents.
3. To establish new relations and connections with other wood and furniture groups that belong to the other bodies such as AIC wood group, Amsterdam Wood symposium, UKIC wood group etc.
4. To cover conservation-restoration issues related to lacquer.
5. To establish a mailing list to join the members together and to have our communication through it.
6. To establish a web site for the WG where we can put in the possible information about our group and where the members can add, share and publish their papers and works etc through the coordinator. The coordinator has already made a mailing list and a web site on Yahoo and a mailing list and an archive on Stanford University Web site (Conservation On Line).
7. To establish a newsletter (or/and) a publication issue or print to publish our member's papers with guest papers of the other ICOM-CC WG members.
8. To try to organize a symposium, conference or a meeting in the second year (2004) for the group and maybe to organize a training course, seminar or workshop.
9. To prepare for having an active session for wood and furniture group in the next triennial meeting in 2005.
