

Legal Issues in Conservation

LIC activities for the 2005-2008 period will be concerned with the following items:

- A. Publication of LIC Newsletters (minimum 1 per year) to be disseminated by e-mail.
- B. Updates on related LIC printed and electronic material.
- C. Expanding a reference database (literature, articles, newspaper articles, web sites, etc.) concerning the trafficking of cultural heritage.
- D. Linking with other parties within ICOM-CC, ICOM and other organizations concerned with the trafficking of cultural heritage.
- E. Linking with other parties within ICOM-CC, ICOM and other organizations concerned with the professional status of conservation professionals.
- F. Creation of National LIC Coordinators that could collect information etc. from within their respective countries.
- G. Consideration of a possible name change for LIC such as: Heritage Law; Heritage Law and Ethics; Cultural Heritage Law and Ethics; Ethics, Law and the Conservation of Cultural Heritage, etc.
- H. Organization of a joint interim meeting with PROMET which will be held in February 2007 in Cairo, Egypt.
- I. Preparation of LIC paper and poster presentations for the 15th Triennial Meeting of ICOM-CC.
- J. Preparations for the continuation of the LIC Working Group following the 2008 ICOM-CC Triennial Meeting.
