

Wood, Furniture and Lacquer

The ICOM-CC-Wood, Furniture and Lacquer program includes the following goals and activities:

- A. To continue to attract more members to strength the group and to strengthen membership for ICOM-CC in whole.
- B. To complete the organizing of the group as a body with general assistant coordinators, assistant coordinators for each continent, and assistant coordinators for specific tasks and the National Representatives of the coordinator in more countries.
- C. To continue issuing our Newsletter through our mailing lists and also starting a new Publication Bulletin to publish papers by our members and by guests from other ICOM-CC WGs.
- D. To establishment our primary website through the Stanford University (Conservation OnLine) website.
- E. Initiating and stimulating conservation projects and research within ICOM member-institutions and international organizations. Proposals for studies, researches and projects themes include several subjects concerning in Consolidation of different sorts of wooden objects, Lacquer and urushi objects. And a study in Preservation of the endangered cultural assets of the traditional Egyptian storytellers' heritage and its instruments and tools.
- F. We intend to organize symposia, conferences and/or meetings. We also want to organize training courses, seminars and workshops.
- G. We plan to prepare an active session of the ICOM-CC- Wood, Furniture and Lacquer at the 15th ICOM-CC Triennial Meeting in Delhi, India from 22-26 September 2008.
- H. To continue strengthening of our connections with related groups and committees that belongs to other organizations, and to strengthen our relations with other ICOM and ICOM-CC committees and groups, and with other international bodies.
