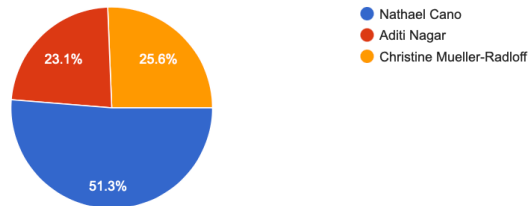

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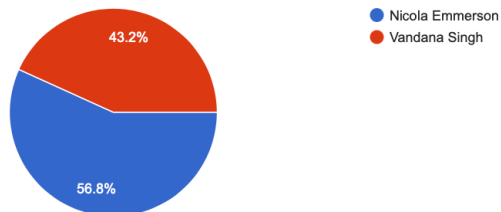


TWO Candidates for Metals Working Group (in alphabetical order)

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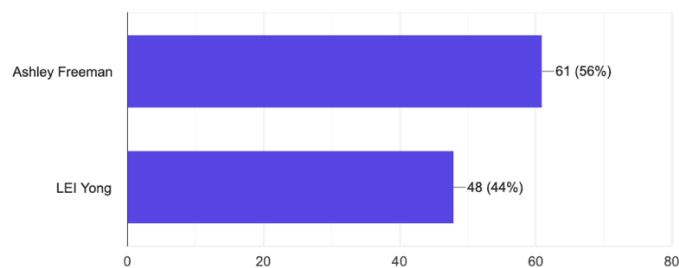


TWO Candidates for Scientific Research Working Group

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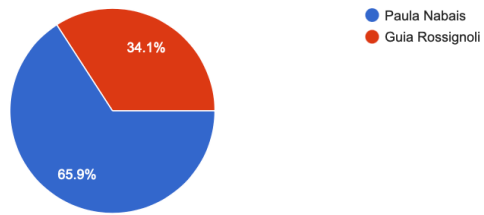
