### 1. ACTIVITIES REPORT

#### 1.1. ACHIEVEMENTS OF THE YEAR

The 15<sup>th</sup> Triennial Conference was held in New Delhi, India; it was the first time that an ICOM-CC Triennial Conference was held in Asia. During 2008 two ICOM-CC Working groups also held interim meetings (Documentation, May 7-10, 2008, Tallinn, Estonia; Art Technological Source Research, June 12-13, 2008, Glasgow, UK).

The ICOM-CC Website was completely redesigned, thanks to a grant from the Getty Foundation.

#### 1.2. ICOM STRATEGIC PLAN

*In what ways has your committee taken actions that contribute to the realization of the Strategic Plan?*

By holding its Triennial Conference for the first time in Asia, ICOM-CC expended its network and established new partnerships. The theme of the conference, *Diversity in Heritage Conservation: Tradition, Innovation and Participation*, allowed taking advantage of the diversity of the conference participants to explore current issues in conservation, including how realistic standards can be implemented while acknowledging regional and cultural differences.

The redesign of the website allowed improving communication within the ICOM-CC membership as well as with the general public to promote heritage and conservation.
